It also implements a number of major infrastructure projects to develop seaports and airports. It also activates partnerships with the different economic pacts, encourages foreign and local investments, expedites the implementation of privatization strategies and programs, and utilizes privatization revenues in setting up projects and investment funds to finance diversification programs.

The government also undertakes a considerable effort to develop SMEs by availing the required funding resources and technical support, enhancing the capacity of the financial institutions to help them make better use of the savings to finance SME projects, improve pension funds' performance through applying sound management techniques, put special interest in R&D at the private and public sectors to increase competitiveness, update the databases of different sectors, helping policy makers formulate well-informed decisions and develop the ICT sector through implementing e-Oman national strategy with more emphasis on promoting e-government initiatives.

VENUE
